

## Proposition 65

Dear valued partner,

Proposition 65, also known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, is a California law approved by voters in November 1986. Its primary objective is to protect California residents from exposure to toxic chemicals by safeguarding the state's drinking water sources. The law prohibits businesses from knowingly discharging listed chemicals into drinking water sources.

Proposition 65 also requires businesses selling products containing certain identified chemicals above defined levels to provide a clear and reasonable warning about potential hazards. For many listed Proposition 65 chemicals, no warning is required if the exposure does not exceed "Safe Harbor" levels. Proposition 65 is administered by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), which publishes and periodically updates a list of chemicals known to cause cancer or birth defects. This list currently includes over 950 chemicals and is available at <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list>.
